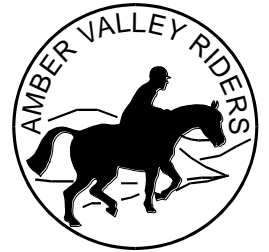


**New Ride Distances!**

**AMBER VALLEY RIDERS LTD**  
**Hope Valley Ride (7,11 or 18 miles)**  
Sunday 1st October 2017  
Hardhurst Farm, Brough, Nr Hope, S33 6RB  
Start : 10-30am – 12noon



**\*\*\*PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE ON SITE BEFORE 10AM\*\*\***

**7 miles** – There is minimal road work but please be aware that on this route there is a small ford crossing (not normally deep). There is also a steep uphill road section (private single track) for about 1/3 mile.  
**11 miles** (original route) This route has minor road work for approximately 1.5 miles and the remainder is via well surfaced bridleways. There is a steep uphill rocky section on this route of approximately 0.5 mile long.

**18 miles** (combines both routes) Please be aware that Riders wishing to do both routes will do the 11 mile route first followed by the shorter route. These are two loops from the venue on opposite sides of the valley. **Note - If you wish to do 18 miles then you must depart the venue by 11am.**

**\*\*\*Please tick ride length choice on the entry form in order to plan marshalling!\*\*\***

Due to the parking area being on a flat camping field, if the weather is very wet the event may have to be cancelled. This would be done prior to the day and notification will be e-mailed to members and put on Facebook.

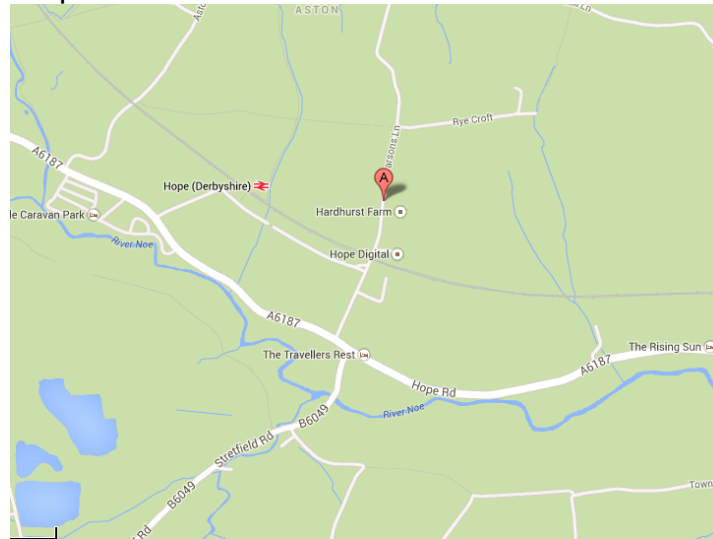

## DIRECTIONS TO VENUE

### Venue – Handhurst Farm Camp Site, Hardhurst Farm, Brough, Nr Hope, S33 6RB

Directions to venue Proceed on the A625 out of Hathersage towards Hope along the Hope Valley road, straight across 1st set of lights after about 2 miles, continue to next set of lights with pub on junction straight through lights and immediately turn right proceed for approx 300yards and take 1st right into caravan / camp site.



## 2017 CLUB RULES

1. All riders must wear approved standard hat whilst mounted and behave in a responsible manner. Please note that hat standards recently changed (2017) and riders are advised to check that their hat meets current standards. Information can be found at [www.bhs.org.uk](http://www.bhs.org.uk) and will be available on our website.
2. All riders under 16 years must be accompanied by an adult.
3. All horses must be in a fit condition either well shod, wear appropriate horse hoof boots or, if barefoot, hooves in good condition to carry out the work expected of them.
4. Tack must be in a safe condition and the horse must wear a conventional bridle. This includes bitless bridles as long as the rider is confident they are in control of their horse. This is for insurance purposes.
5. Minimum age of participating horses is 4 years without exception. Participating horses should also be ridden and not in hand.
6. Riders must be covered by their own third party insurance and sign a disclaimer. **Proof of valid third party insurance must be provided with membership. If renewal is within the season then it is the responsibility of the rider to provide proof of this renewal before subsequent ride events.**
7. Club tabards to be worn during the ride over the top of outer clothing so the numbers can be seen, and to be worn only by the rider they are issued to. Non-members will be allocated a pink number bib which must be returned upon completion of the ride.
8. Riders must slow to a walk when approaching other riders from behind and warn them of their intention to pass.
9. Riders must show consideration to pedestrians and other road users. Riders must stay on the path/track and not stray onto farmer's land or cross privately maintained grass/lawn/verges.

**The committee reserves the right to penalise any riders for breaking ANY of the above rules.**

**IMPORTANT - If your insurance has expired then your ride entry will be refused.**
